

SEMAGLUTIDE MEDICATION SCHEDULE

MONTH #1

Pyridoxine/Sodium Semaglutide 25/1mg/mL Injection Solution, 1mL vial

Inject 0.25mL (25 units on insulin syringe) Sub-Q once weekly for 4 weeks

*You will have some left over in your vial, you can advance to 0.3mL (30 units on insulin syringe), using what is left until you receive your second vial.

MONTH #2

Pyridoxine/Sodium Semaglutide 25/1mg/mL Injection Solution, 2mL Vial

Inject 0.5mL (50 units on insulin syringe) Sub-Q once weekly for 4 weeks

MONTH #3

Pyridoxine/Sodium Semaglutide 25/2.4mg/mL Injection Solution, 2mL Vial

Inject 0.4mL (40 units on insulin syringe) Sub-Q once weekly for 4 weeks

MONTH #4

Pyridoxine/Sodium Semaglutide 25/2.4mg/mL Injection Solution, 3mL Vial

Inject 0.71mL (71 units on insulin syringe) Sub-Q once weekly for 4 weeks

MONTH #5 AND THEREAFTER

Pyroxidine/Sodium Semaglutide 25/2.4mg/mL Injection Solution, 4mL Vial

Inject 1mL (100 units on insulin syringe) Sub-Q once weekly and thereafter
